Downstream Activities



OIL REFINING

Oil refining converts crude oil to other items via a number of different processes using heat and pressure.



SUPPLY AND TRADING

Moves crude oil from where it is produced to where it is processed. Transports refined products from refineries to retailers.



PRODUCT MARKETING

Develop and implement strategies to maximize ROA while forecasting future sales quantities, enabling distribution departments to adjust operations.



WHOLESALE AND RETAIL SALES

Wholesale involves long-term relationships with a few customers to sell bulk quantities of product. Retail sales are organized around classes of trade, i.e. company owned stations, company owned dealer operated stations, dealer owned, and dealer operated stations.
