


## A VISUAL GUIDE TO SAFE PPE USE FOR DENTAL PRACTITIONERS

According to the CDC, high risk jobs are those with potential for exposure to known or suspected sources of COVID-19. Workers in this category include dental professionals performing aerosol-generating procedures (eg. cough induction procedures, some dental procedures, exams or invasive specimen collection). It is important to wear PPE to protect yourself and others from COVID-19.

## **MEDICAL GLOVES MUST HAVE**

- Standard AQL 2.5 or less (Lower AQL minimizes potential risk of contamination due to pinhole defects)
- Conforms to ASTM F1671 and EN ISO 374-5 VIRUS (Barrier against viral penetration)
- Conforms to EN 455 (Standard for medical exam gloves)
