ONSET	<p><b>Immediate</b> Reaction occurs within minutes after exposure</p> <p><b>Late</b> Reaction occurs 8-12 hours after early phase</p>	<p><b>Delayed</b> Symptoms 6-48 hours after initial contact</p>	<p><b>Immediate</b> Symptoms within minutes to hours after initial contact</p>
